Unrestricted Gifts

An Unrestricted Gift to CLA is the most favorable form of bequest as it allows us to use your donation in the areas of most need. An example of a clause that could be included in your will is provided below.

“I give to Community Living Association Inc, 5 Nundah St, Nundah, QLD 4012 the sum of \$_____ (or *property* or *securities*, *describe*) to be used in such manner as its Management Committee determines.

I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of the said organisation shall be sufficient discharge to my Executor for the said bequest.”

Designated Gifts

A Designated Gift is when you specify how you would like CLA to use your contribution. We will make every effort to respect your wishes. However, in the event that its original purpose becomes inappropriate as situations change over the years, a provision in your Will permitting CLA to redirect the funds is most useful. For example:

“I give to Community Living Association Inc, 5 Nundah St, Nundah, QLD 4012 the sum of \$_____ (*or property or securities, describe*) for the specific purpose of..... (*describe where you want the gift to be used*) but if such purpose cannot in the opinion of the Management Committee of the organisation be achieved, then to be used in such manner as its Management Committee determines.

I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of the said organisation shall be sufficient discharge to my Executor for the said bequest.”

Residuary Gifts

A Residuary Gift provides for CLA to receive whatever is left of your estate after specific bequests have been fulfilled. For example:

“I give to Community Living Association Inc 5 Nundah, Nundah, QLD 4012 all the residual and remainder of my estate (after payment of funeral and testamentary expenses and any duties payable on the estate before the residue is determined) to be used in such manner as its Management Committee determines.

I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of the said organisation shall be sufficient discharge to my Executor for the said bequest.”
